## Notes

The Prelude and Fugue in C minor, BWV 847, is a keyboard composition written by Johann Sebastian Bach. (1685 - 1750).

It is the second prelude and fugue in the first book of *The Well-Tempered Clavier*, a series of 48 preludes and fugues by the composer.

The Piano Sonata No. 18 in E-flat major, Op. 31, No. 3, is an 1802 sonata for solo piano by Ludwig van Beethoven. (1770-1827). Its nickname "The Hunt" is due to one of its themes' resemblance to a horn call.

The Ballade No. 4 in F minor, Op. 52 is a ballade for solo piano by Frédéric Chopin, completed in 1842 in Paris and published in 1843 with a dedication to Baroness Charlotte de Rothschild. Being his last published ballade, the piece is commonly considered one of the masterpieces of piano music.

The Piano Sonata No. 5, Op. 53, is a work written by Russian composer Alexander Scriabin (1872-1916) in 1907. This was his first sonata to be written in one movement, a format he retained from then on.
